
Chart Round-Up: 2024's First Week Back

RCA's Tate McRae spends a 5th consecutive week atop the Pop/CHR chart with "Greedy", while the second official radio single from McRae's Think Later ("Exes") pulls in 72 new adds upon impact and is already #18 on the chart and climbing.

Republic's Taylor Swift hits 17 weeks at #1 on Hot AC with "Cruel Summer", tying the record for longest-running solo female #1 in the format's history (alongside Colbie Caillat's "Bubbly" in 2007-08). Columbia's Miley Cyrus leads the AC chart for a 35th week with "Flowers" after the format's switch back from holiday music. The song extends its record as the 3rd longest-running



#1 in the chart's history and also marks a full year charting at Hot AC, making this her first single to do so. Over at Country, **Warner/WAR**'s **Dan + Shay** earn their milestone 10th #1 single with "Save Me The Trouble"; the title track from the duo's *Bigger Houses* will impact the format on Feb 5th as the album's second single.



Generation Now/Atlantic's Jack Harlow rises to #1 at Rhythmic with "Lovin On Me" as the single returns to #1 on *Billboard*'s Hot 100. It's his 4th career chart-topper at the format. **Epic**'s **Tyla** holds #1 at Urban for a 4th nonconsecutive week with "Water", which is #13 and climbing at Pop/CHR. **Beautiful Life Music**'s "Still Believe in Love" by **Mary J. Blige** feat. **Vado** holds #1 at Urban AC for a second week.

At Alternative, **Columbia**'s **blink-182** spends a 12th consecutive week at #1 with "One More Time"; it marks the band's second consecutive

single to spend that long atop the chart. At Triple A, **Island**'s **U2** spends a 6th non-consecutive week at #1 with "Atomic City"; it's the band's 14th format chart-topper. **Reprise**'s **Green Day** and their "American Dream is Killing Me" spends an 8th consecutive week at the top of the Active Rock chart.

On the first add board of 2024, **Republic**'s **Nicki Minaj** (feat. **Lil Uzi Vert**) lead Rhythmic and Urban with "Everybody". **Leo33**'s **Zach Top** is the most-added single at Country with "Sounds Like The Radio" as both the artist and label's radio debut.

"Yes, And?"...What About It? Republic's Ariana Grande Returns This Friday

Republic's multi-format superstar Ariana Grande is set to make her return to the airwaves this Friday with the release of "yes, and?" The song, Grande's lead-off to an imminent 7th studio album, will hit Pop/CHR and Hot AC immediately with an official add date of next Mon/Tues. Produced by Grande, Max Martin, and Ilya, it should come as a clear blockbuster debut, with an Audacy programmer deeming it "excellent". The song will have a runtime of 3:35 and heavily interpolates Madonna's "Vogue". "Yes, And?" will mark Grande's first solo radio single since "POV" in 2021.


